Notice of Educational Options and Accountability Report

According to Wisconsin Statute 118.57, the state requires that all school districts include information on their website about educational options for all children who reside in that district.

The Bayfield School District offers a variety of educational options to children who reside in the District.

The District's primary educational pathway and instructional program for students involves a progression from 4-year-old kindergarten through 12th grade, leading to a high school diploma.

Some of the specific education programs offered to eligible students who are enrolled in and attending the District's schools include the following:

- Early childhood special education (for students who are at least 3 years old but not yet school-age)
- Special education for students with disabilities
- English Language Learner (ELL)
- Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs
- Individualized program and curriculum modifications
- Acceleration-Middle School Students can take high school Math classes for credit
- Alternative Education Programs grades 6-12
- GEDO2 grade 12
- Summer School programming grades 4K-12
- Dual College Credit opportunities grades 11-12
- Independent Study opportunity grades 9-12
- TAP Program (after school program) grades K-8
- Ojibwe language and culture instruction
- School-Age Parent Support
- At-risk programming (e.g., for students identified as being at-risk of not graduating from high school)
- International Travel Opportunities grades 9-12
- Early College Credit Program (ECCP) grades 11-12
- Wisconsin Educational Opportunity Program including GEARUP grades 6-12
- Career and College Readiness programming grades 6-12
- UW-Green Bay Rising Phoenix Early College High School Program grade 10
- Collaborative Programming with Red Cliff Early Childhood Center & Bayfield Family Forum
- Ojibwe Immersion Program grade KG
