Strategic Priority - Academic Achievement and Rigor

- **I am extremely excited to report that Bayfield Elementary School will be receiving the Wisconsin Title I School of Recognition award again this year. The Schools of Recognition award is presented to schools leveraging federal Title I funding to provide additional resources and services to economically disadvantaged students. The staff and students of Bayfield Elementary earned an award for BEATING THE ODDS for three consecutive years.**
- **The week of April 13th we started virtual teaching and learning for our students. All K-5 staff and LaPointe staff have created a Google Classroom where they assign tasks to students. All instruction and classroom activities are aimed at specific learning targets that are essential for students' success in the next grade level. See attached 4K-5 Learning Days Expectations. I've also attached the special education services document that we are utilizing to deliver services and plan for our students with an IEP (the document is adapted from the Elmbrook School District).**

Strategic Priority – Positive and Supportive School Climate

- **Since the school has been closed, staff have been very busy building virtual classrooms and participating in a number of professional development activities. CESA 12 has been offering free share shops for all staff in their respective areas (i.e. Occupational Therapy, Elementary Teachers, K-5 Special Education Teachers, etc.). Many of our staff are taking advantage of these opportunities to learn from colleagues in their field and to share ideas on virtual teaching and learning.**
- **On April 3rd we held our first staff book study on The Trauma Sensitive Classroom Building Resilience with Compassionate Teaching by Patricia A. Jennings. There are 46 staff members participating in the book study and have been meeting virtually to discuss chapter readings on Friday, April 17, Friday, April 24 and Friday, May 1.**
