## Covid/Covid Response

- Collaboration with Red Cliff Tribal Council, Red Cliff Community Health Center, Bayfield County Health continues.
  - Nick Sawyer continues to work on Covid response plan and protocol, as well as a matrix.
    - an all staff training schedule has been drafted
    - inventory of district PPE for staff and students is complete
    - weekly all staff meetings occur Tuesdays @ 3:00

#### **Personnel**

- All School Board approved new hires are on staff and working on training, orientation and meeting colleagues.

## **Teaching and Learning**

- Supplemental training for teachers on Canvas continues.

Student engagement and family outreach will be coordinated through the Dean of Students and the Elementary and MS/HS Principals with the Home School Coordinator and Guidance Counselors as well as Case Managers and SpEd Director as needed. We are focusing on creating a circle of support for students and families.

- ECCP
  - HS principal, HS guidance counselor and I are working on promoting ECCP options for BHS students. The deadline to register for college courses is October 1 for the spring semester.

# **Effective Communication**

# Ojibwe Culture
