Academic Achievement:

Supportive Climate:

Staff have been supporting each other as much as possible setting up Canvas and working out the glitches. Week one and two went quite smoothly, minimal technology mishaps. Family and students that initially had frustrations were contacted, worked through the issues, and currently moving in a positive direction.

Effective Communication:

Due to the pandemic we've had major changes to the Drivers. Ed. program in regard to Behind the Wheel (BTW) scheduling. Final paperwork with DOT and DPI is being completed to keep our program accredited and available to students.

Use of Data & Resources:

Education Galaxy and This is Reboot are two online resources newly purchased to use to enhance lessons. Education Galaxy is available in certain subject areas (ELA and Math, levels 6-8, and Science, level 8). This is Reboot is available grades 6-12 to support daily SEL at the beginning of the day.

Attendance:

Attendance in online Canvas courses has been exceptionally high.
