The data from the 20-21 Forward Exam reinforced what we learned from our spring '21 STAR and F&P data. Many of our students are not working at the projected levels for their age and the task for our teaching staff is to identify the key skills that need to be learned and mastered by them to successfully move forward. Our five new elementary teachers will be a huge asset to our students and teachers in getting things back on track coming out of this pandemic that clearly has caused academic delays in our children.

Supportive Climate:

Our 21-22 SY "Open House" was a success! Our staff welcomed back over 100 families and helped ease the transition for our students from summer back to school. It was great to see such support from our families bringing their children in to meet their new teachers and the rest of our staff. Events like this remind us of the importance of the school and family connection.

Effective Communication:

We have been reaching out to families with communications about the start of the school year by mail, email, student and family handbook, school website and Facebook. Our teachers have been communicating with the students and families they serve.

Use of Data & Resources:

Our upper elementary teachers have had the opportunity to look through the state data from our '21 Forward exam to look for patterns and areas to focus our instruction this year. All of our elementary teachers also have access to students' STAR and Fountas & Pinnell data from last year to help understand where their students are with their math and reading skills. Once students and teachers have had a chance to develop a relationship in the classroom, we will conduct our Fall screeners to further help guide instruction, enrichment and interventions.

Attendance:

We are having a great start to our 21-22 SY as far as attendance goes. While it is early in the year, we are starting out with a positive foundation and we will look to build on it with our PBIS framework. Bayfield

Elementary School's attendance rate is 92.8% and La Pointe Elementary School's rate is 96.4%. It's great to see so many of our students strive to be here each day.
