### **Updates and Changes**

• We are requesting that all persons vaccinated or unvaccinated wear masks.

- The pool is open for lap swim 5 days/week from 6:30-10am and 12-2pm, and for a family open swim on Saturdays from 10-2. For the family open swim, the pool is open with a single lap lane available. We are asking for reservations for open swim to ensure we don't go over our limit of 25 patrons in the pool at a time. Lap swimmers are scheduled 2/lane with one lane open to a single person with special spatial needs or a helper in the pool with them.
- Cardio/weight equipment is available not requiring reservations for this area as visits have not been excessive for the space and hours available.
- · Sauna is currently open to ages 16+
- Hot tub pump replacement was completed and the hot tub has been open since
- Our new Program Director Cole Schreiner started on August 16th and our new Executive Director Jacob Kaiser is set to start on September 20th.
- Hired an additional Lifeguard and Red Cross Certified Swimming Lesson Instructor.
- We are currently hiring lifeguards, cleaners, and a Silver Sneakers instructor.
- There is a lifeguard certification course scheduled for September 24th-26th.
- We are scheduled to be closed the week before Apple Fest (Sept. 25 Oct. 3).
