#### Community Collaborations and Partnerships:

BFI (Brighter Futures Initiative...Boys & Girls Club) lead Brandon Barnes has taken a new position. Wade Hanson, Bayfield High alum, will be taking over until the position is permanently filled; Paige Moilanen from Boys & Girls Club will be assisting. They will continue to work with middle school students during 8th period on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

#### **Efficient Use of Resources:**

Middle school lunch/recess has been trying new options due to limited gym use and colder weather. The library is an option for students to use, quietly and with no food, as long as they are productive. Chromebooks may be used. More supervision in cafeteria and commons for students to congregate there as well.

Attendance was down a bit on the Friday, December 9th, when only 6-12 had school. K-5 was an inservice day. Middle School's attendance was 81.27% and the High School's attendance was 77.93%. Reports are attached. I will continue to monitor percentages on future K-5 inservice days.
