Impact Aid Program Update

We received another Impact Aid payment on 05/08/2023. This was the final payment for fiscal year 2021 and was for \$268,236. This leaves us with \$198,988 above last year's payments. The final Basic Support proration was 100%, with a ratable increase of 1.51% added to each districts Learning Opportunity Threshold (LOT). This was the first time we received 100% of our LOT since I have been with the district. The final rate for CWD (Children with Disabilities) payments was \$1,175.24 per student. Once the Impact Aid Department release all fiscal year 2021 remaining funds in the coming weeks, they will turn to closing fiscal year 2022.

Coronavirus Relief Funding/ESSER Update

We are currently using these funds to pay for additional staff and supplies dealing with coronavirus.

- ESSER III Funding \$1,509,323.00 \$871,624 = \$637,699
- Remaining spending for the 2022-23 school year will be \$206,582
- Balance for the 2023-24 will be \$431,117
- We are hoping to fund 4 co-teachers and 1 reading specialist for the 2023-24 school year

Health Insurance Renewal Information

Attended the Northern School District Trust Fund's annual meeting. We voted to stay with Health Partners for the next fiscal year. The increase for the Bayfield School District was a 10% increase. Below shows the breakdown of how that will affect us.
