Summer work continues

- Act 20 work:
 - Review key provisions of the legislature to ensure compliance with 24-25 SY mandates
 - Complete Keys to Literacy training Modules 1-4 to stay ahead of the schedule for the upcoming teacher training in September and October.
 - Update 3 Year Literacy Plan for K-5 to include Act 20 training and our Guaranteed and Viable Curriculum in ELA - this involves reviewing and revising our priority standards, refining our units of study that address the priority standards, creating common assessments and rubrics.
- Prepare for and attend the School District of Bayfield Literacy Data Retreat.
 - Reviewing data in WISEdash Local to look for trends in literacy to prepare for the 24-25 SY.
 - Review data from the Forward Exam for grades 3-5 to look for trends in literacy.
- Reviewing and finalizing the K-5 schedule. This schedule was built to maximize large blocks of instructional time at each grade level as well as providing common planning time for grade level teachers.
